320th Bombardment Group (M).

19 B-26's took off at 1053 hours to bomb Munschheimer Supply dump W/R: (\*) 4-836682, GADS 4416, sheet V-2. 1 A-26 returned early. Total sorties: 18. 18 B-26's dropped 145 x 500 lb GP bombs (.1, .62, second delay fuses) at 1246 hours from 11,000' to 11,100' on an axis of 265 degrees true. 1 x 500 lb bombs was returned to base having hung up. No B-26's lost and no A-26's are missing. 2 B-26's slightly damaged by flak and 13 B-26's returned to base at 1428 hours. \*

Weather: CAVU all the way.

RESULTS: The second squadron had good concentration on the target. Bombs of the first squadron landed at (\*) 4-807679.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: Briefed axis to IP -- 27 degrees.  
Drift correction over IP -- plus 9.  
Evasive action at IP -- loss of altitude.
