VIAHINGEN BARRACKS AND DEPOT AREA (M/R: (W) R-990160, GSOS 4416, Sheet W-3), Germany.

At 12:22 hours, 28 B-26's took off to bomb Vishingen Barracks and Depot Area (M/R: (W) R-990160, GSOS 4416, Sheet W-3), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early; spare. Total Sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the Primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 138 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (inst. nose & non-delay tail fuses) and 9 B-26's dropped 70 x 500-lb. M-17 Incendiary Clusters with M-138 nose fuses set at 19 seconds on the Primary target at 14:37 hours from 12,300' to 11,300' on an Axis of 350°T. 4 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were salvaged at 14:40 hours at (W) W-9898. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's were lost or missing. 2 B-26's slightly damaged by flak; 1 seriously damaged by flak. 27 B-26's returned to base at 16:35 hours.
