At 09:55 hours 28 B-26's took off to bomb Ebenhausen Ammo factory, S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Area "A" (M/R: (W) T-747170, GSGS 4416, Sheet W6), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: Spare. Total Sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the primary target and 27 B-26's dropped 370 x 250-lb demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) on the primary target at 12:20 hours from 12,000' to 11,000' on an axis of 214 Deg. True (Briefed Axis: 192 deg. True. Drift Correction: None. Evasive Action: Loss of Altitude). No bombs were salvaged and no bombs were returned to base. No B-26's were lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 13:53 hours.
