
SUBJECT: Aircraft lost over Target.

TO : Statistics Department, 320th Bombardment Group.

- lead ship, first squadron, as Flight Commander with the hh2nd squadron when I looked out to the right and saw an sircraft from our second squadron (hh4th) on firs. The ship was in z gentle dive appearing to be under control. The left side of the ship was in flames. I personally saw the figures jump out of the ship and they seemed to come out of the bomb-bays or waist windows. I followed the forms for about five seconds but did not see the chutes open. The aircraft continued in a gentle dive for another five seconds or so and then seemed to go out of central and into a spin. I surmise the pilot let go of the cont rols and then the ship started into a spin. It spun about 2,000 or 3,000 feet and blow the ground shortly thereafter and another large explosion occurred. I personally did not see any more than three figures bail out of the aircraft and I did not see their chutes open.
- 2. An enlisted man, S/Sgt. John d. Harl, 120572h3, gave me his account of what he saw. This account follows:

and immediately saw the left engine burst into flames. Seconds later he saw two men bail out and drop guite a ways before their chutes blossomed. He saw three men bail out (probably the same three Isaw) and they too dropped guite a ways before the chutes opened. He then states that after the ship went into a spin and dive, that he saw another man get out and chute open. A second or two later the ship blev wo. 3/Sgt Earl also states that it appeared to him that small arms fire was coming up at the last man to bail out.
