

STATEMENT

A/C, Battle # Ol, was hit by E/A fire over Garda, F-4470 at 11:28 hours. It slid out of formation, the pilot evidently fighting for control. Three (3) chutes emerged; and one minute later the right wing came off, A/C turned over on its back, and crashed into a mountain exploding at F-6091.

Corporate Pior and Loshlein from this post, delivered the prisoner of war, American pilot Lt. Cole, to the British Prisoner of War Comp Obsrursel.

Lt. Cole was captured on 25 December 1944 about 11:45 o'clock near the place of Brazzacco, Northern direction from Ugine, together with three English Army personnel. Captured by men of the Staff II Signal Communication Segment 200.

The three British Army personnel were turned over to the Menurity Funt on Union.

Lt. Cole was snot deem by pursuit planes on 6 Nov. 1864 from a plane (Marander) in the vicinity of Roversto (Merthern direction from Lake Garda). The whereabouts of the other six crew members is not known to him (Lt. Gole). At this time Cole drifted in the mountains of Morthern Italy, round about trying to reach the Yugoslavian border. Attached is the identification the Brigade Garibald captured from him.

It is requested, that Corp. Fier and Localism give a confirmed report of the American Prisoner and that they, according to transfer orders, proceed to transfer the prisoner.
