## Intelligence Marrative No. 114, Day Operation, 25 December 1943.

Flight Commander: Major Marble.

1. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

2. At 1050 hours, 32 5-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (H) took off to bomb Pisa M/Y, Italy. They were unescorted. 6 5-26's returned early; 1 because oil congeoled, 1 because of oil leak, 1 lost the formation in the clouds, 1 lost

power and 2 flew cover for the a/c that lost power.

22 B-26's dropped 1/4 x 500 lb denolition bombs 1/10 .025 second delay fuses on the target at 1305 hours from 9,000'. 2 3-26's dropped 12 x 500 lb demolition bombs on Pontedera A/D. 12 x 500 lb demolition bombs were salvoed because of rack failure. 72,000 nickels were dropped in the target area. 26 8-26's returned safely to this base at 1528 hours.

- an excellent pattern of bombs was woven across the center and 3. Results: east positions of the M/Y. Considerable rolling stock and sheds in the yards were destroyed. Some bombs landed short in the town and others landed over. Hits were scored on the landing strip at P. ntedera A/D.
