- 2. At 1115 hours, 1 8-26 of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Albinia Sailroad Bridge, Italy. It was unescorted. 10/16 cloud cover with cieling at 300' prevented bombing. 1 B-26 returned safely to base at 1435 hours.

 - 4. Observations:
- General: A radio station was seen on point of land at 420 251 h. 11° 06' E at 1325 from 100'.

- G. Knemy Air Tactics: None Enemy Shipping: 2 submarines were seen in straits to between Corsica and Sardinia at 1404 from 250'.
