- A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).
- B. At 1025 hours, 24 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (k) took off to bomb the RR Bridge at Orvieto, North, Italy. They were unescorted. None returned early. 23 B-26's dropped 35 x 1000 lb. demolition bombs (1/10 - .025) second delay fuses on the target at 1238 hours from 9300'. 6 of these bombs were dropped at the RR tracks at the target having hung on the original bomb run: 4 x 1000 lb. demolition bombs were dropped on acquapendente bridge at 1230 because the bombadier thought a run was being made on the target. 5 x 1000 lb. demolition bombs having hung were salvoed, 4 over land and 1 over water. 1 x 1000 1b. demolition bomb having hung was returned to the base. 24 B-26's returned to this base at 1417 hours.
- C. Results: An excellent pattern of bombs bracketed the bridge with on. direct hit towards the east end and one probable hit in the center.
