Intelligence Narrative No. 182, Day Operation, 6 April 1944

Flight Commander: Major Macia.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 1030 hours, 28 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Massa RR Bridge, Italy. 4 Spares returned early. 24 B-26's were over the target at 1240 hours at 10,000' but no bombs were dropped due to 10/10 cloud cover. 8 x 1000 lb. demolition bombs were salvoed due to mechanical emergency. 88 x 1000 lb. demolition bombs were returned to this base. 24 B-26's returned at 1420 hours.

C. Results: None.

D. Observations: None.

E. Routes and Altitudes: From 2500' at this base to Forte del Marne, climbing gradually to 10,000'; curve left over the target at 10,000'; reciprocal course to base.
