- A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).
- B. At 13:20 hours, 40 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Incisa RR Bridges North and South, Italy. 4 spares returned early. 24 B-26's were over the North Bridge, and dropped 192 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 15:36 hours from 9,100' to 8,300'. 12 B-26's were over the South Bridge and dropped 96 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 15:37 hours from 9,600' to 9,500'. 28 B-26's returned to base at 17:54 hours, and 7 B-26's returned late between 18:45 hours and 19:43 hours after landing at Corsica for gas. 1 B-26 is at Ghisonaccia, Corsica, having been badly damaged by flak; the crew returned to base in another aircraft.
- C. Results: The North Bridge was covered by an excellent pattern of bombs, scoring probable direct hits. The South Bridge was missed, the bombs landing over East of the target.
