Intelligence Narrative No. 214, Day Operation, 23 May 1944

Flight Commander: Lt. Col. Macia.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (A).

B. At 08:15 hours, 40 B-26's of the 320th bombardment Group (A) took off to bomb Velletri Road Junction, Italy. 1 B-26 returned early because of ill crew member. 39 B-26's were in the target area at 10:11 hours at 11,000', but no bombs were dropped because of complete cloud cover. 32 x 500# Demolition bombs (long delay fuses) were salvoed in the water on the return. 280 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) were returned to base. 38 B-26's returned to base at 11:42 hours and 1 B-26 returned to base late at 12:42 hours after landing at Naples due to minor engine trouble.

C. Results: None.

D. Observations: None

E. Weather:

- a. Enroute: 6/10ths cumulus; tops, 6,000'.
- b. Target: 6/10ths cumulus at 8,000' to 5 miles inland; 9-10/10ths over target and building up inland to 15,000'.
- c. Return: As Enroute.

F. Routes and Altitudes: From 2,500' at base, to landfall at Sabaudia; to Priverno at 11,000'; to Norma; to South of Littoria; to Sabaudia; to base.
