Intelligence Narrative No. 250, Day Operation, 13 June 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Annallee.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 06:56 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb two 400' block ships at Leghorn Harbor, Italy. 2 spares returned early. 18 B-26's were over the target and dropped 72 x 1,000# Demo. (1/10 & .01 second delay fuses) on the target at 08:52 hours from 9,400' to 10,400' on an Axis of 135 T. 18 B-26's returned to base at 10:23 hours.

C. Results: The target was covered with an excellent pattern of bombs scoring several direct hits and causing huge explosions. One of the boats was half sunk by a formation which preceded this group over the target.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

a. Air Activity: 2 Spitfires were seen diving on a B-Boat just East of Gorgona Island.

b. Situation: None.

2. Ground:

a. Weather: None.

b. Communications: None.

c. Flak: From Leghorn, moderate to intense heavy accurate for altitude, inaccurate to accurate for deflection and scant light inaccurate was encountered. Barrage, followed by continuously pointed fire. Started on bomb run and continued on the breakaway.

Positions:

4 light guns at C/2 (TC 3-103A-NA).

2 - 4 gun heavy batteries 1 1/2 miles South of Leghorn along road.

3 heavy guns at L/3 (TC 3-103A-NA).

Several heavy guns at East edge of Leghorn.

3 yellow bursts as bombs down opened, following which flak started coming up.

Several large gray bursts were seen.

4. Shipping:

(1) Parachute in water 2 miles off Leghorn; 2 a/c were circling.

(2) 3 ships were seen shelling Leghorn Harbor.

(3) 1 small M/V beached at Maloria Island.

(4) 2 med M/V at Viareggio Harbor.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: 5.

4. Weather: CAVU in all cases.

E. Routes and Altitudes: From 2,500' at base, to Capria Island; 0°T to point off Viareggio, right turn to Axis of 135 T, to target; sharp break right to Capria Island; to base.

F. Comments: None.
