Intelligence Narrative No. 260. Day Operation, 17 June 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Shuh.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 0610 hours, 20 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Pontassieve RR Bridge (M/R: Q942682). Last Resort: Castiglioncello RR Bridge (M/R, U092309). 2 spares returned early. The primary and secondary targets were obscured by clouds and the last resort was bombed. 18 B-26's were over the target and dropped 144 x 500 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .01 second delay fuses) on the target, bombed at 1036 hours from 9,000' to 8,500' on an axis of 65° T. 18 B-26's returned to base at 1201 hours.

C. RESULT: Half the bombs landed in an excellent pattern on the bridge, scoring probable direct hits covering the tunnel mouth, south approaches and road bridge inland. The other bombs landed just left to the north of the target.

D. OBSERVATIONS:

1. Air: a. Air Activity: Spitfires were seen in the target area at 1000 hours.

b. Situation: None.

2. Ground: a. General: None.

b. Communications: 1. 60 MM cars at 0122Z.
2. 30 MM cars at 0142Z.
3. 15 M/T facing south, stationary at Q4529 at 0948 hours.

c. Flak: From Montenero, 25 bursts, scant heavy, accurate for altitude, inaccurate for deflection was encountered just at bombs away. Continuously pointed fire in bursts of three.

d. Shipping: 1 small L/V headed north at 0102Z at 1034 hours.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: None.

4. Weather: a. Enroute: 6/10 cumulus at 8,000'.

b. Target: 9/10 cumulus, 9,000' to 13,000'; target open below overcast.

c. Return: As enroute.

E. ROUTES AND ALTITUDES: Base to Elba; around west end of Elba; to Cecina; to Peccioli; to Castaglionfiorentino; curve left around Empoli; to Cecina; curve left at sea; to target; breakaway right to base.
