Intelligence narrative No. 298, Day Operation, 4 Aug. 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Hunter.

A. 320TH BOMBARDMENT GROUP (M).

B. At 0849 hours 13 B-26's took off to bomb Ventimiglia RR Bridge east (N/R: S-880872, sheet 102). 1 B-26 returned early, which was a spare. 12 B-26's were over the target and 9 dropped 36 x 1000 lb bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 1054 hours from 10,600' on an axis of 340°. 12 x 1000 lb demolition bombs were returned to base: 8 because A/C were not in a position to drop on the target; 4 having hung up over the target. 12 B-26's returned to base at 1239 hours.

C. RESULTS: The target was missed. One flight's bombs landed just west of the bridge and others landed just NE of the bridge.

E. ROUTES: Identical with other mission (2 runs on target).

F. COMMENTS: Cloud cover over water reaching to just short of land prevented accurate bombing.
