Intelligence Narrative No. 316, Day Operation, 19 August 1944.

Flight Commander: Col. Fletcher.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 07:03 hours, 29 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb the Road Bridge South of Embrun (M/R: (B) P-296584, GSOS 4249, Sheet 150), France. 1 B-26' returned early: Spare. 28 B-26's were over the target, and 28 B-26's dropped 112 x 1,000# Demolition Bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the target at 09:28 hours from 12,500' to 12,000' on an Axis of 63°T. 28 B-26's returned to base at 11:27 hours.

C. Results: The bridge was missed. The bombs of two Squadrons landed to the right of the target, cutting the East approach. The bombs of the third Squadron landed to the left of the target cutting the North approach.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

a. Air Activity: P-38's and P-47's were seen in the target area.
4 unidentified Z/E a/c, behind the formation headed North-West at 10,000' in the vicinity of the target.

b. Situation: None.

- (1) Hospital at Voix.
- (2) Bridge out at Espinasses.

b. Communications:

- (1) 50 RR cars at Mirabeau.
- (2) 75 RR cars at Peyruis.
- (3) 10 RR cars at Chateauroux.

- (5) 15 RR cars and 2 stationary locomotives at St. Crepin at 09:32 hours.

(6) 30 RR cars at Digne.

(7) 8 M/T headed West, 8 miles West of Digne at 09:42 hours.

(8) 5 M/T moving North into Peyruis from the South at 09:17 hours.

c. Flak: None.

d. Shipping: None.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: None.

4. Weather:

a. Enroute: Broken cumulus at 5,000' along coast of France.

b. Target: Open.

c. Return: As enroute.

E. Routes: Base to I. De Port-Cros; to landfall at C. Blanche; to Pignans; to St. Paul Le-Durance; to IP, Peyruis; bomb run to target; sharp curve right over Crepiu; over target; to Digne; to C. Blanche; to base.
