Intelligence Narrative No. 324, Day Operation, 1 Sept. 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Berge.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 0646 hours, 11 B-26's took off to bomb Pontecorone Road Bridge (M/R: (Q) 012100, sheet 70). 2 B-26's returned early, which were spares. This formation dropped on the first run on the target, but followed another formation bombing the rail bridge on three runs. 9 B-26's were over the target and 9 dropped 36 x 1000 lb demolition bombs (1/10 .01 second delay fuses) on the target at 0858 hours from 8,000' to 7,500' on an axis of 03 degrees. 9 B-26's returned to base at 1135 hours.

C. RESULTS: A good pattern covered the bridge, with several probable hits scored, a few bombs landed short to the south.
