Intelligence Narrative No. 346. Day Operation, 14 Sept. 1944.

Flight Commander: Captain Rowan.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (A).

B. At 08:30 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Defense Position Mt. Oggiali Area, Area NR-1 (M/R) (W) L-871136, GRS 4164, Sheet 98, Italy. No B-26's returned early. 19 B-26's were over the target and 9 B-26's dropped 126 x 250-lb demolition bombs (Instantaneous Nose & .025 second delay tail fuses) and 10 B-26's dropped 1,110 x 20-lb fragmentation bombs on the target at 10:27 hours from 12,200' to 11,700' on an axis of 356 Deg. True. 90 x 20-lb fragmentation bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up over the target. 19 B-26's returned to base at 12:15 hours.

C. Results: An excellent pattern covered the entire target area with bomb and fragmentation bomb bursts.

D. Observations

1. Air:

a. Air Activity: P-47's and Spitfires were dive-bombing and strafing gun positions in the target area.

b. Situation: None.

2. Ground:

a. General: None.

b. Communications: (1) 20 M/T headed North 1 mile S of Traversa at 10:26 hours.

(2) 4-5 M/T in target area at 10:27 hours.

c. Flak:

Target S. H. A. FA GP 5H 3 miles NE of Pallazzuola Encountered from 10 seconds before bombs away and 35 sec. on breakaway

d. Shipping: None.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: 4 due to flak.

4. Weather:

a. Enroute: Scattered cumulus, bases 6,000', tops 7,000', over Sardinia. Few scattered patches of low stratus over water. Italy clear. Visibility 15 miles in light haze.

b. Vicinity of Target & Target: Clear. Visibility 15 miles in light haze.

E. Routes: Base to mouth of Ombrone River; to Siena; to L. San Pietro A Sieve; to target; break right to Marradi; to Siena; to mouth of Ombrone River; to Base.

F. Comments: Correction to Bomb Data on Narrative No. 345.
