A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 11:04 hours, 18 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Calcinate RR Bridge (M/R: (R) N-191600, GSSS 4164, Sheet 47), Italy. 18 B-26's were over the target on two bomb runs, but no bombs were dropped, due to cloud cover. This formation was over the target at 12:26 hours 12443 hours from 10,600' to 8,000' on Axis of 01°T. All bombs were returned to base. 18 B-26's returned to base at 14:02 hours.
