A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 1422 hours 20 B-26's took off to bomb Calcinate RR Bridge (M/R: (A) P-191600, GSOS 4164, Sheet 47,) Italy. 2 B-26's returned early: spares. 18 B-26's were in the target area, but no bombs were dropped due to complete overcast. The formation turned around in the vicinity of the target at 15:36 hours from 11,200'. All bombs were returned to base. 18 B-26's returned to base at 1647 hours.
