Intelligence Narrative No. 38A, Day Operations, 20 Oct., 1944

Flight Commander: Captain Berge.
Lead Pilot: Captain Wilhelm.

A. 320th Bombardment Group (M).

B. At 08:25 hours, 40 B-26's of the 320th Bombardment Group (M) took off to bomb Pisani Railroad Bridge (M/R: (R) G-249145, GSOS 4164, Sheet 64), Italy. 1 B-26 returned early: Spare. 39 B-26's were over the target and 38 B-26's dropped 151 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & no delay tail fuses) on the target at 10:41 hours from 11,600' to 11,100' on an Axis of 270°T. 5 x 1,000# Demolition bombs were salvoed in the water on return, having hung up over the target. 38 B-26's returned to base at 12:13 hours. 1 B-26's is missing. It was last seen to leave the formation at Ancona on the return trip and is believed safe at a friendly field.

C. Results: An excellent concentration of bombs covered the target, scoring at least 5 direct hits.

D. Observations:

1. Air:

a. Air Activity:

- (1) 8/10 unidentified S/E a/c seen North of the target.
- (2) 1 unidentified S/E a/c followed the formation from the coast to the target, high and far to the rear.
- (3) 1 unidentified a/c 10 miles West of the target, flying at 12,000'.
- (4) P-47's escort picked up formation, and was again seen in the target area.

b. Situation: None.

2. Ground:

a. General:

- (1) Bivouac area North of Adria.
- (2) 2 active factories South of Chioggia; 1 active factory at Loreo.
- (3) Area South of Loreo appeared flooded.

b. Communications:

- (1) 8/10 M/T headed North from Stranghella at 10:42 hours.
- (2) 90 RR cars at Solesino.
- (3) 25 RR cars at Monelice.
- (4) 4 M/T on coast road moving North near mouth of Po di Lavante River at 10:58 hours.

c. Flak:

Target: M-I, H, A, A - CP. 8 H at 1/14 (TG: 4-Bl-NA)
12 H at 1/16-17

Vicinity of Adria: S, L, I, I.

Heavy Flak: First encountered 20 seconds before bombs away and 15 seconds on breakaway. Second 18 encountered for 60 seconds on bomb run and for 45 seconds on the breakaway.

c. Flak: (Cont'd)

When flak had almost ceased, 1 large yellowish burst was seen
4,000' above the formation.

Only 2 a/c in the first 18 were damaged by flak.

d. Shipping:

(1) 6 barges in canal North of Loreo.

(2) 4 small boats and one medium boat headed South-East at
 $44^{\circ} 55'$ North/ $12^{\circ} 35'$ East.

3. Losses: None. Damaged: 18 due to flak. 1 injured crew member, due to flak.

4. Weather:

a. Enroute: CAVU.

b. Vicinity of target: CAVU.

c. Target: CAVU.

d. Return: CAVU.

E. Routes: Base to Grosseto; to Pesaro; to landfall at mouth of Po di Levante River; to Cavazzere; to Target on an Axis of 270° T; breakaway sharp right break to mouth of Po di Levante River; reciprocal course to base.

F. Comments: 6 cartons of "Chaff" were carried and dropped. See special "Chaff" report, to follow. Missing A/C landed at Falconara, Italy.
