Final Mission Report No. 394

320th Bombardment Group (M).

CASSANO DI ADDA RAILROAD BRIDGE (M/R: (Q) K-500679, GSOS 4164, Sheet 46), Italy.

At 14:24 hours, 20 B-26's took off. 2 B-26's returned early; take-off was delayed due to crashed a/c, and was unable to locate the formation; 1, spare. 1 B-26 lost on take-off, due to engine failure. 2 crew members killed; 3 crew members injured; and a/c was destroyed. 17 B-26's were over the target. 17 B-26's dropped 62 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .01 second delay fuses) and 6 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (6-hour delay fuses) on the Primary target at 15:53 hours from 11,000' to 10,000' on an Axis of 16° T. No bombs were salvoed. No bombs returned. 17 B-26's returned to base at 16:55 hours. No B-26's lost or missing. 6 B-26's slightly damaged by flak. No B-26's seriously damaged.

RESULTS: A good pattern of bombs landed on the target, with the center of impact to the East. A few possible hits were scored.

ENEMY AIR OPPOSITION: None.

FLAK: M, H, A, A, GP type flak encountered from the target. The flak was first very inaccurate, low and to the right of the formation. It commenced 2 minutes before bombs away, and became accurate on the bomb run itself. The accuracy decreased sharply on the breakaway from the target.

ROUTE: See report No. 392, same, except for the Axis which was 16° T.

WEATHER: See report No. 392, same.

AIR OBSERVATIONS: None.

NAVAL OBSERVATIONS: None.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS: See report No. 392.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: A Squadron of 8 a/c preceded this formation across the target area by 2 minutes. Of this Squadron, all dropped chaff. The lead flight was briefed to bomb small bridge just West of the Primary target here, and wing flights were briefed to bomb gun positions East and West of the target. Crew members believed that frags, different Axes, altitudes, and chaff confused enemy gunners, effecting accuracy, especially just before the bomb run and on the breakaway of the formation.
