320th Bombardment Group (M).

MISSION: DEL. GRAFNA RAILROAD BRIDGE (M/R) (R) B-241071. OSGS 4164, Sheet 37, Italy.

At 10:42 hours, 19 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early: spare. No B-26's lost prior to the target. 18 B-26's were over the target. 18 B-26's dropped 63 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 nose and last. tail fuses) and 6 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (6-hour delay fuses) on the primary target at 12:31 hours from 10,600' to 9,600' on an axis of 43°T. 3 x 1,000# Demolition bombs (1/10 nose and last. tail) were salvaged over land having hung up over the target. No bombs were returned to base. 18 B-26's returned to base at 14:02 hours. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's slightly damaged or seriously damaged.

RESULTS: A good pattern covered the bridge, scoring at least two direct hits on the bridge and several on the East approaches.
