320th Bombardment Group (M).

QUADRICO RAIL CUT (N/R; (R) F-588805, CGG4 4164, Sheet 46), Italy.

At 09:55 hours, 18 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early: engine cutting out. No B-26's lost prior to target. 17 B-26's were over the target. 17 B-26's dropped 129 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) on the Primary target at 11:26 hours from 10,500' to 9,500' on an Axis of 46° T. No bombs were salvaged. 7 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) were returned to base, not having been dropped due to bombardier error. 17 B-26's returned to base at 12:36 hours. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's slightly or seriously damaged.

RESULTS: The bombs landed generally East of the target, with one or two possible hits or near misses on the target.

AIR FIGHTER POSITION: None.

FLAK: M, H, I, L, SP type flak encountered from Paschiera, F-425h. Long deflection shots.

ROUTE: Base to Monéglio, F-4028; to Bidenna, F-9094; to Desenzano, F-3059; to L^o, Lanise, F-4562; bomb run to the target on an Axis of 46° T; breakaway left to Desenzano, F-3059; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER: a. Enroute: Over coast, one band of strato-cumulus at 3,000' to 6,000'; layer of strato-cumulus over Apennines.
b. Nearby of Target: Scattered patches in haze over Po Valley.
c. Target Area: CAVU.
d. Return: As enroute.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:

- a. Air Activity: B-25 formation was seen attacked by 4/A and shot at by flak, South of Trento, B-7621, at 11:29 hours.
F-47's were seen at various places over enemy territory.
- b. Situation: Ghedi A/B, F-9957, appeared empty at 11:16 hours.
