320th Bombardment Group (M).

FOULI TOWN CONCENTRATION (M/N) (W) W-440184, GGGS 4164, Sheet 100, Italy.

At 11:05 hours, 22 B-26's took off. 10 B-26's returned early. 10 B-26's lost prior to target. 22 B-26's were over the target. 11 B-26's dropped 1,320 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs on the primary target at 13:04 hours from 9,600' to 10,200' on an axis of 296°T, and 11 B-26's dropped 1,320 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs at (W) W-430197, due to target misidentification. 10 bombs were salvaged or returned. 22 B-26's returned to base at 14:05 hours. 10 B-26's lost or missing. 4 B-26's slightly damaged by flak. 10 B-26's seriously damaged.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern of bombs covered the target area.

WASPY FIGHTER OPERATIONS: None.

FLAK: S. H. A. I, Sp G type flak encountered from Ferli (W) W-4324. Encountered from bomb-release line for 15 seconds into breakaway. Flak decreased after initial bursts, in accuracy; accurate for altitude for only first squadron.

ROUTE: Base to join up at Pianosa Island; to Senigallia, (W) W-3759; to O. Rimini N/E, (1) W-8994; to IP, Savignano, (2) W-7202; to target on an axis of 296°T; breakaway sharp left to Cesena, (W) W-5907; curve right, direct to base.

WEATHER:

- a. Clouds: Scattered cumulus over water, becoming overcast over land. Tops between 6,000' and 8,000'.
- b. Vicinity of Target: Abrupt break in clouds 10 miles west of target; clear to east and in the Po Valley.
- c. Target Area: Open.
- d. Return: As enroute.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:

- a. Air Activity: Many friendly W/N a/c were seen dive-bombing and strafing in the vicinity of the target at 13:04 hours.
- b. Situation: None.

NAVY OBSERVATIONS: None.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS:

- a. General:
  - (1) Tall column of black smoke at (W) W-5636 at 13:02 hours.
  - (2) Artillery flashes were seen south of Ferli at (W) ~~W-3813~~ W-3813 at 13:05 hours.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS: (Cont'd)

a. General: (Cont'd)

(3) Smoke in target area at 13:04 hours.

b. Communications: Scattered M/T traffic moving in both directions, between Bologna, (W) L-8949, and Ferli, (W) M-4317, at 13:04 hours.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: Correction of Final Mission Report No. 399, 6 November 1944, the early return is credited with a sortie.
