Final Mission Report No. 403

320th Bombardment Group (A).

ITALY THROU CONVENTION (A/R) (A) N-440185, C-408 41th, sheet 100), Italy.

At 11:26 hours, 23 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early; spare. No B-26's were lost prior to target. 22 B-26's were over the target. 21 B-26's dropped 2,376 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs on the Primary target at 13:05 hours from 10,000' to 11,400' on an axis of 294°T. 1 B-26 dropped 120 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs 1,000 yards west of the target because toggle-bombardier dropped on his flight leaders salve, the salve due to malfunction. 114 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up over the target. No bombs were returned to base. 22 B-26's returned to base at 14:16 hours. No B-26's were lost or missing.
2 B-26's slightly or seriously damaged.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern of bombs covered the target area, causing fires and explosions.
