320th Bombardment Group (M).

ALA STATION AND STORES (M/R; (R) F-666898, GSGS 4164, Sheet 36), Italy.

At 09:40 hours, 19 B-26's took off. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 guns jammed; 1 engine cutting out. No B-26's were lost prior to the target. No B-26's were over the target. The formation turned back at Padua, G-3448, due to weather at 11:42 hours from 10,000'. 21x 500# demolition bombs: 4 (6-hour delay fuses); 9 due to rack malfunction; 8 because of flak damage. All other bombs were returned to base. 15 B-26's returned to base at 13:20 hours. No B-26's were lost. 2 B-26's missing: 1 B-26 with hydraulic system shot out is believed to have landed at Falconera A/D, with another B-26 as escort. 2 B-26's slightly damaged, by flak. 2 B-26's seriously damaged, by flak.

RESULTS: None.

MILITARY FIGHTER OPPOSITION: None.

FLAK: S-A, M, A, A, -OF type flak encountered from Loreto, G-5820, both going in and coming out. 4 H guns at G-5010; 6 H guns at G-5810; 4 H at M-7098.

M, H, I, I, -Barrage type flak encountered from Chioggia on return.

Long deflection shots. 8 H guns at G-6525.

ROUTE: Base to Rimini, (S) R-8693; to mouth of Po Di Tolle, M-8087; to Padua, G-3448; left curve to S. Urbano, G-1618; to Pegolette, G-4625; to mouth Po Di Levante, G-7308; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER:

- a. Enroute: Clear from Florence to Rimini and over Adriatic.
- b. Vicinity of target: Over East Po Valley, altostratus overcast, base 10,000'.
- c. Target Area: Heavy storm North and West of Padua.
- d. Return: As enroute.

- a. Air Activity: P-47's and B-25's seen in the target area.
- b. Misnations: None.

NAVAL OBSERVATIONS:

- a. Ports and Harbors: None.
- b. Shipping: Many barges and other small boats in the vicinity of M-7090 at 11:30 hours.

a. General:

- (1) Active factory at G-4302 and at Adria, G-4710, at 11:55 hours.
- (2) 6 large oil tanks at Cavarzere, G-5028, at 11:55 hours.

b. Communications:

- (1) Scattered W/T traffic moving North in the Vicinity of Monselice, G-4430, at 11:48 hours.
