SAN AMBROGIO RAILHOAD WILL (M/R: (R) F-518642, GSGS 4164, Sheet 48); (-Alternate: GRMA RAILHOAD BRIDGE (M/R: (Q) K-634508, GSGS 4164, Sheet 46), Italy.

At 12:19 hours, 20 B-26's took off. 4 B-26's returned early: 1 engine cuiting out: 1 electrical system smoking; 2 escort. (3 entitled to sorties). No B-26's lost prior to the target. 16 B-26's were over the target. 9 B-26's dropped 69 x 500# Demolition bombs (1/10 a .025 second delay fuses) and 3 x 500 memolition bombs (6-hours delay fuses) on the target of opportunity, HALLHOAD THACKS South of ALA (M/R: (R) F-674900), at 14:10 hours from 11,600' to 11,400' on an Axis of 116"T. Both the Primary and the Alternate targets were cloud obscured. 8. x 500 # Demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) were salvoed by A/C with engine cutting outs and 2 x 500 # Demolition bombs (6-hour delay fuses) were salvoed, and 6 x 500 # Demolition bombs (1/10 & .02) second delay fuses) and 1 x 500 Demolition bomb (6-hour delay fuses) were salvoed by early returns. 48 x 500% Demolition bombs (1/10 & .02) second delay fuses) were returned to base by the second Squadron. Hadio contact with the lead Squadron failed and second Squadron did not know of the plan to bomb a target of opprotunity. 16 B-26's returned to base at 15:27 hours. ho 2-26's were lost, or missing. 10 B-26's slightly damaged by flak. No B-26's sercously damaged.

Hard Ta: The HH tracks were missed. The bombs landed in a good pattern just Last of the tracks on a road, cratering it.

Flak: M. H. A. A. -OF type flak encountered from Ala. 1-6690. Ancountered 10 seconds before bombs away and for 1 minute into the breakaway.

Salo, F-2973; to 5 miles short of Primary target; to F-5575; to target of Opprotunity on an Axis of 1169T; breakaway right to Montechiari, F-1853; to Fiorenzuola, K-7801; to Moneglia, P-4028; to base.
