RASTATT RR BRIDGE (M/R): (N) W-351288, G908 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany.

At 1110 hours, 28 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early due to engine trouble. No B-26's were lost prior to the target. 27 B-26's were over the target; no B-26's dropped on the primary target but were over the target at 1316 hours from 13,000-12,300 feet on an axis of 120 Degrees. No bombs were salvaged and all bombs were returned to base due to weather. 27 B-26's returned to base at 1425 hours. No B-26's were lost and none are missing; no B-26's were slightly damaged.

RESULTS: None due to weather.

ENEMY FIGHTER OPPOSITION: None.

W.L.K.: None.

ROUTE: Base to Nancy at U-8511, rendezvous with P-47's; to Saarbourg G-5016; to North R-0037. LF to target area; right break, reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER: 10/10 Strato-cumulus, tops 8,000', breaking to 6/10 near Dijon. No change at target and the same on the return except for a few breaks near Nancy.
