320th Bombardment Group (A).

AIRFIELD AREA AT STEINFELD, BOMBARDED BY (4/R) (1) R-223306, (2) R-223498, (3) R-217498, and (4) R-217506, GUNS 4416, Sheet V-2, Germany.

At 13:06 hours 18 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early; crew member ill. No B-26's lost prior to the target. 17 B-26's were over the target. No B-26's dropped due to overcast. Lead Navigator was not sure of position on first run, returned for second run but could not locate the IP again. The formation was over the target at 14:30 hours from 12,200' to 11,200' on an Axis of 35° T. 4 x 1,000" demolition bombs (1/10 & .025 second delay fuses) were salvaged safe through the overcast by a/c returning alone on single engine at (4) Q-9719 due to emergency. All other bombs were returned to base. 17 B-26's returned to base at 14:33 hours. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's slightly or seriously damaged.
