At 1118 hours 27 B-26's took off. No B-26's returned early. No B-26's lost prior to the target. 27 B-26's were over the target and 27 B-26's dropped 108 x 1,000 lb demolition bombs (1/10, .025 second delay fuses) on the primary target at 1311 hours from 12,400' to 11,400' on an axis of 26° true. No bombs were salvaged. No bombs were returned to base at 1448 hours. 27 B-26's returned to base at 1448 hours. No B-26's lost. No B-26's are missing and no B-26's slightly or seriously damaged.

RESULTS: An excellent concentration of bombs covered the target area, scoring many direct hits on defenses.

ENEMY FIGHTER OPPOSITION: None.

FLAK: S, H, I, I, 8 bursts only encountered from the target.
