Total sorties: 35. 35 B-26's were over the target (2nd Alternate), due to weather, (primary & 1st alternate) 10/10 overcast, and 26 B-26's dropped 208 x 500 lb demolition (1/10 x .025 second delay fuses) on Cos Barracks M/R: (W) R-336206. 6 B-26's were over the 2nd Alternate target and 6 B-26's dropped 120 x 100 lb W/P bombs on the 2nd Alternate target at 1411 hours from 12,000' to 11,600' on an axis of 63 degrees true. 8 x 500 lb demolitions (.1, .025 second delay fuses) were salvaged at 1412 hours in the target area due to bomb bay door trouble of the flight leader. 16 x 500 lb demolitions (.1 x .025 second delay fuses) were returned to base due to bomb bay door trouble of flight leader and wing ships followed suit.
