FINAL MISSION REPORT NUMBER 145.

KALISPLAUTEN BARRACKS, M/R: (W) R-053940. GRS 4416. Sheet U-2.

320th Bombardment Group (M).

At 1040 hours, 19 B-26's took off. 2 B-26's returned early; 1 Personnel & 1 Engineering. 17 B-26's were over the target and 14 B-26's dropped 110x 500-lb demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) and 3 B-26's dropped 70 x 100-lb W/T bombs (M4 Bursters) and (M126 nose fuse) on the target at 1301 hours from 11,000' to 10,500' on an axis of 332 Degrees. (2 x 500-lb bombs having hung up, were salvoed in Lake at R-0343. 13 x 100-lb bombs having hung up were salvoed in the target area. 7 x 100 bombs were returned to base having hung up and could not be salvoed. No B-26's were lost and none are missing. No B-26's damaged. 17 B-26's returned to base at 1408 hours.

AIR OBSERVATIONS: A. Activity: 12/24 P-47's provided escort. A/C formation in Neu-stadt area, possibly B-26's.

B. Situation: None.

MISCELLANEOUS: None. LOSSES TO E/A: None. DAMAGED BY E/A: None.
CLAIMED E/A: None.

FLASH: W/I H I I CP. From target area. 30 seconds before bombs away and for one minute thereafter.

Losses to Flash: None. Damaged by Flash: None.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS: (1) One B-26 of the 17th Group smoking, into a glide afame at 2,000', no chute seen. Headed into woods in target area. (2) AA fire in northerly direction at R-1045. (3) Large fires at R-2057. (4) 10 Barracks at R-1593. (5) Possible AA guns at R-1894 and R-0592. (6) Marker flak observed at Lembach, R-0343.

B. Communications: (1) 60 RR cars at R-1767. (2) 30 RR cars at R-1501. (3) 15/20 W/T heading East at R-0595.

CASUALTIES: None. NUMBER OF A/C ATTRIBUTING PHOTOGRAPHS: 4.

ROUTE: Base to Saverne to Annweiler. IP to target; break right; reciprocal course.

WEATHER: See Report Number 1, this date.

RESULTS: Excellent concentration of bombs across target.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: Briefed axis over IP was 20 Degrees. Drift Correction over IP ---- Plus 6. Evasive Action at IP ---- Left and Right.
