At 1030 hours 19 B-26's took off. 1 B-26 returned early. Spare. 18 B-26's were over the target and 15 dropped 117 x 500-lb demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) and 3 B-26's dropped 57 x 100 w/p bombs (14 x 1126) on the target at 1300 hours from 10,300' to 9,300' on an axis of 330 Degrees True. 4 x 100-lb Bombs having hung up, would not salvo in the target area, were salvoed in lake at 0043. 3 x 500-lb bombs were returned to base, having hung up and would not salvo. No B-26's were lost and none are missing. 4 B-26's were slightly damaged by flak. 18 B-26's returned to base at 1414 hrs.
