LABACH W/Y (W/R: (n) 4-400899, GSOS 4416, sheet V-2), Germany.

At 12:04 hours, 22 B-26's took off to bomb Labach W/Y (W/R (n) 4-400899, GSOS 4416, sheet V-2), Germany. 4 B-26's returned early: Spares. Total sorties: 18. No B-26's were over the target and no B-26's dropped 500-lb, Demolition bombs. Formation turned back at Volklingen, G-3573, at 13:55 hours, from 10,800', due to complete overcast in the area. No bombs were salvoed. All bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 15:22 hours.
