GUN POSITIONS NEAR LABACH (W/R: (U) Q-391869, GSGS 4416, sheet U-1), Germany.

At 12:09 hours, 4 B-26's took off to bomb Gun Positions Near Labach (W/R: (U) Q-391869, GSGS 4416, sheet U-1), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: spare. Total sorties: 3. 3 B-26's were over the target and 3 B-26's dropped 360 x 25-lb. fragmentation bombs on the target at 14:00 hours from 10,200' on an axis of 10°T. No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's damaged. No B-26's lost or missing. 3 B-26's returned to base at 15:02 hours.

ROUTES: Base to Luneville Q-0800, rendezvous; to Homberg Q-3059; to Volklingen Q-3673, IP; to target (briefed axis over IP - 10°T; evasive action over IP - loss of altitude; drift correction over IP - 10° right); break right to Volklingen Q-3673; to Homberg Q-3059; to Luneville Q-0800; base.

Weather:

a. Enroute : stratocumulus overcast, bases 3,000', tops 4,000', at base, breaking to clear 30 miles to the North and continuing clear to Luneville. Visibility unlimited.

b. Vicinity of Target:

c. Target Area : From Luneville to target and in the target area 2/10ths stratocumulus in small patches, bases 3,500', tops 4,000'. Visibility unlimited.

d. Return : Stratocumulus on last 30 minutes of route had broken to 3 - 4/10ths coverage.

RESULTS: Target missed - bombs landed over and to the left.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: 21 boxes of "CHAFF" dropped from Hornberg to the target and return to Hornberg. No impressions as to effectiveness.
