At 12:25 hours, 22 B-26's took off to bomb Labach Supply Depot (W/R: (2) -400899, GSGS 4416, sheet U-1), Germany. 4 B-26's returned early: spares. Total sorties: 18. 16 B-26's were over the target and 13 B-26's dropped 72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) and 69 x 500-lb. M17 Incendiary bombs (M-138 fuses set at 19 seconds) at 14:07 hours from 11,100' to 10,500' on an axis of 09°T. 3 x 500-lb. M17 Incendiary bombs hung up and were salvoed at 14:08 hours in the target area. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 15:17 hours.
