BAD MUNSTER RAILROAD BRIDGE (M/R: (W) M-083351, CGGS 4416, Sheet T-2), Germany.

At 12:42 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Bad Munster Railroad Bridge (M/R: (W) M-083351, CGGS 4416, Sheet T-2), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: engineering. Total sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the target and 18 B-26's dropped 139 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & non-delay tail fuses) at 14:47 hours, from 11,500' on an Axis of 302°T, on the second run. Second Squadron of this formation dropped on the 4th run at 15:05 hours, from 11,200' on an Axis of 105°T, due to inability to align on the target on the previous three runs. 8 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed at 12:57 hours, 5 miles East of base (engine cutting out) after take-off, at (W) O-1967. Bombs landed safe in an open field, 5 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed on the breakaway, having hung up. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 16:07 hours.
