EBINGEN RAILROAD SIDINGS (M/R: (H) W-959575, GOGS 4416, Sheet X-3), Germany.

At 11:52 hours, 7 B-26's took off to bomb Ebingen Railroad sidings (M/R: (H) W-959575, GOGS 4416, Sheet X-3), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: Spare. Total sorties: 6. Primary was not bombed due to weather and 6 B-26's were over a target of opportunity, St. Georgen M/Y (M/R: (H) W-455475), and 6 B-26's dropped 42 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) and 6 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (6 hour and 12 hour delay fuses minus anti-removal device) at 13:31 hours from 10,500' on an Axis of 35°T. No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's damaged. 6 B-26's returned to base at 14:58 hours.

ROUTE: base to Selestat V-7963; to Bleibach, IP (briefed axis over IP - none; evasive action over IP 4 less of altitude; drift correction over IP - none); to Neustadt W-3623; broke left to target; to Offenburg W-1587; to Selestat; to base.

WEATHER:

a. enroute : base to Spinal, clear with light ground haze. Spinal to Selestat, scattered altostratus at 10,000'. At Selestat the altostratus became multi-layered, increasing in coverage and thickness to the south and east.

b. vicinity of target:

c. target area : 8,500', increasing to 10/10ths, base 5,000' to 6,500', tops estimated 15,000', at Gengen, extending to the North and East over all areas. Flights going below the overcast found targets in Ludwigshafen area open from 5,000' with visibility 8 to 10 miles in haze. Flights going above the overcast were forced to turn back at Gengen and found targets of opportunity open through 7/10ths cloud cover in the Neustadt area.

d. return: As enroute.

RESULTS: Good concentration across the target area.
