STANDENBULL RAILROAD BR. (M/R: (A) N-172098, Q/R: 4416, sheet 0-2), Germany.  
At 10:46 hours, 29 B-26's took off to bomb Standenbuhl Railroad Bridge (M/R: (A) N-172098, Q/R: 4416, sheet 0-2), Germany. 3 B-26's returned early; spares, spares of 1st formation joined this formation at rendezvous. Total sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the primary target and 27 B-26's dropped 214 x 500-lb. demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) at 12:24 hours from 11,000 to 10,000 feet on an axis of 344 degrees true. 2 x 500-lb. demolition bombs were salvoed at 12:25 hours in the target area. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 13:38 hours.
