SIEGELSBACH AMMUNITION DUMP, "AREA Q" (M/R: (W) R-949747, GSOS 4416, Sheet U-3), Germany.

At 12:55 hours, 49 B-26's took off to bomb Siegelbach Ammunition Dump "Area Q" (M/R: (W) R-949747, GSOS 4416, Sheet U-3), Germany. 4 B-26's returned to base early: Spares. Total Sorties: 45. 45 B-26's were over the Primary target, and due to weather at the Primary and Alternate targets no B-26's dropped No x 500-lb. Demolition bombs on the target, and made 2 bomb runs. The formation was over the Primary target at 15:15 hours from 12,000' to 10,000' on an Axis of 40°T. 8 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs, due to bombardier error, were salvoed at 15:14 hours at the target area. 7 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs, due to engineering trouble, were salvoed at 15:40 hours at W-1563. 33 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (6 hour and 12 hour long delays) were salvoed at W-3668 at 15:37 hours. 4 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs, 2 long delay, and 2 due to rack malfunction, were salvoed in lake South of base at 16:30 hours. 62 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were .1 & .025 second delay and 10 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were 6 hour and 12 hour delays) were dropped at W-3668 at 15:37 hours. These bombs landed in the hills and no damage resulted. Some were dropped due to bombardier error, who saw that the long delay was being salvoed, and others by A/C that followed suit in dropping on a Squadron lead. All bombs salvoed were in enemy territory, except those salvoed in the lake South of base. Remainder of bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 45 B-26's returned to base at 16:37 hours.

 - (6) Several hundred white balls at 12,000' of various sizes from 3 to 16 inches in diameter seen from W-0563 to R-7704 at 14:10 hours to 14:25 hours.
