KIRKEL AMMUNITION AND SUPPLY AREA (M/R) (W) Q-598765, GSGB 4416, Sheet U-1), Germany.

At 11:55 hours, 39 B-26's took off to bomb Kirkel Ammunition and Supply Area (M/R) (W) Q-598765, GSGB 4416, Sheet U-1), Germany. 3 B-26's returned early. Spares. Total Sorties: 36. 36 B-26's were over the Primary target and 36 B-26's dropped 282 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay fuses) at 13:25 hours from 12,500' on an Axis of 16° T. No bombs were salvoed or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 36 B-26's returned to base at 15:35 hours.

- b. Vicinity of Target : CAVU.

RESULTS: Excellent concentration of bombs fell in the target area - causing fires and at least 1 large explosion.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: Counter-Battery fire observed striking in assigned area, believed good.
