SINGFRIED LINE DEFENSES EAST OF ZHEIBRUCKEN (M/H: (W) 4-757708, GSGS 4416, sheet V-2, GERMANY.

19 B-26's took off at 0630 hours to bomb the siegfried line befores east of zweibrucken (M/R: (W) q-757708, GSGS 4416, sheet V-2), Germany. No B-26's returned early. Total sorties: 19. 19 S-26's were over the primary target and dropped th 264 x 250 lb demolition bombs (.1, non-delay fuses) on the primary target at 0752 hours from 11,600' to 10,600' on an axis of 22° T. No bombs were salvoed or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 1 B-26 damaged by flak. 19 B-26's returned to base at 0836 hours.
