SIEGFRIED LINE DEFENSES EAST OF ZWELBRUCKEN (M/R; (W) Q-757708, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany.

At 07:06 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Siegfried Line Defenses East of Zweibrucken (M/R; (W) Q-757708, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: engine cutting out. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target and 16 B-26's dropped 222 x 250-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & non-delay fuses) on the Primary target at 08:28 hours from 11,600' to 10,600' on an Axis of 46°T. 2 B-26's salvaged 28 x 250-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & non-delay fuses) 6 miles South-West of the target at (W) Q-731613, due to bombardier error. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 9 B-26's damaged by flak. 1 B-26 seriously damaged by flak; 18 B-26's returned to base at 09:28 hours.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:

a. Activity:

- (1) 4 P-47's circling burning a/c at Q-5718 at 08:29 hours.
- (2) 1 U/I black a/c in the target area at 5,000' at 08:27 hours.
- (3) P-47's provided area cover and were seen straffing and dive-bombing.

FLAK: M, H, A, A, & CP type flak encountered from the target area. Commenced 2 minutes before bombs away and 15 seconds into the breakaway. Started high, became accurate, and finished low.

1 B-26 & CATEGORY II.

RESULTS: Crews reported that the bombs started in the center of the target area and walked to the road in the next area North.

Bombs dropped on the target now reads 222 x 250-lb. Demolition bombs dropped, SHOULD read 219 x 250-lb. Demolition bombs dropped on the target, and add to bombs salvaged, 3 x 250-lb. Demolition bombs were salvaged in the target area, having hung up.
