320th Bombardment Group (M).

SIEGFRIED LINE DEFENSES EAST OF ZWEIBRUECKEN, GERMANY, M/R: (W) 4-757706, GSOS 4416,  
SHEET V-2, (AREA 8A).

At 1357 hours 18 B-26's took off to bomb Siegfried Line Defenses east of Zweibruecken, Germany (Area 8A). No B-26's returned early. Total sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 252 x 250 lb demolition bombs (.1, non-delay fuses) on the primary target at 1530 hours from 12,000' to 11,000' on an axis of 46° T. No bombs were salvoed and no bombs were returned to base. No B-26's were lost and no B-26's are missing. 3 B-26's slightly damaged by flak and 18 B-26's returned to base at 1653 hours.

Losses to E/A: None. Damaged by E/A: None. Claimed E/A: None.

FLAK: S, H, A, A, CP type flak encountered from the target area, commenced 15 seconds before bombs away, stopping then. Total of 20/25 bursts.

RESULTS: The bombs landed just north of the assigned area walking thru the next area north. Bombs of the second squadron covered the west end of the assigned area.
