320th Bombardment Group (M).

SIEGFRIED LINE DEFENSES EAST OF ZWEIBRUCKEN, Areas 10A, 8A, and 6A (M/R: (W) Q-757708, CGGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany.

At 09:02 hours, 20 B-26's took off to bomb Siegfried Line Defenses East of Zweibrucken, Areas 10A, 8A, and 6A (M/R: Q-757708, CGGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early; engine cutting out. Total Sorties: 19. 19 B-26's were over the Primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 142 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (Inst. nose & non-delay fuses) on the Primary target at 10:32 hours from 11,350' to 11,500' on an Axis of 01° T. 1 B-26 dropped 8 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs 6 miles South of the target, due to bombardier error. No bombs salvoed or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 19 B-26's returned to base at 11:47 hours.
