SIEGFRIED LINE DEFENSES WEST OF ZWEIBRUCKEN, Areas 5D and 6D (M/R: (W) Q-695705, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-1), Germany.

At 15:57 hours, 20 B-26's took off to bomb Siegfried Line Defenses West of Zweibrucken, Areas 5D and 6D (M/R: (W) Q-695705, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-1), Germany. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 20. 20 B-26's were over the target and 20 B-26's dropped 158 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & non-delay tail fuses) on the target at 17:07 hours from 12,300' on an Axis of 11°T. No bombs were salvoed or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 20 B-26's returned to base at 18:09 hours.
