At 11:00 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Rinnthal Railroad Embankment and Bridges (M/R: (W) R-134688, GSOS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: spares. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target, but no bombs were dropped, due to cloud cover. 18 B-26's were over the Alternate target and 18 B-26's dropped 72 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .01 second delay tail fuses) on the Alternate target, Neustadt M/T (M/R: (W) R-302835, GSOS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany, at 12:51 hours from 11,600' to 10,600' on an Axis of 51° T, on "ETA", due to cloud cover, which prevented a bomb run. No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 13:59 hours.
