ROAD AND RAIL BLOCK AT ALBERSWEILER (M/R: (S) R-207689, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-2),
Germany.

At 09:55 hour, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Road and Rail block at Albersweiler (M/R: (W) R-207689, GSGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early: engine inoperating. Total sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 140 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 11:27 hours from 12,600' to 10,500' on an axis of 193°T. No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. 1 B-26 lost in crash landing at base, due to flak damage; crew is safe. No B-26's missing. 10 B-26's slightly damaged by flak; 2 B-26's seriously damaged by flak. 17 B-26's returned to base at 13:07 hours.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern of bombs were seen to cover the target area, scoring many hits on the town.

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
