ROAD AND RAIL BLOCK NORTH-WEST OF HAUNSTEIN (N/R: (W) R-073668, OGGS 4416,
Sheet V-2), Germany.

At 09:56 hours, 20 B-26's took off to bomb Road and Rail Block North-West of Haunstein (N/R: (W) R-073668, OGGS 4416, Sheet V-2), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: spares. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 141 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the primary target at 11:13 hours from 10,040' to 9,950' on an Axis of 05°T. 1 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs was salvoed at 11:14 hours in the target area (not malfunction). No bombs were returned. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 12:24 hours.
