At 13:14 hours, 40 B-26's took off to bomb Eberstadt Ammunition Factory and Storage Area, North part of Area "C" (M/R: (W) M-648348, GSGS 4416, sheet T-3), Germany. 4 B-26's returned early: 3 spares; 1 engineering. Total sorties: 36. 36 B-26's were over the Primary target and 36 B-26's dropped 283 x 500-lb. demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 15:43 hours and 16:13 hours from 12,600' and 10,800' on an Axis of 05°T and 330°T. 1 x 500-lb. demolition bombs were salvaged at 16:18 hours at M-8920, having hung up. No bombs were returned to base. Second Squadron made a second bomb run, as "BAT" equipment had not coincided with correct navigation and bombed with a "HORDEN" in back up a/c. No B-26's lost or missing. 5 B-26's damaged: CATEGORY I, 2 B-26's damaged: CATEGORY II. 36 B-26's returned to base at 17:40 hours.
